

Call for applications for The "SAINT-ANTOINE-EBMT ACHIEVEMENT/YOUNG-LEADER AWARD 2024"

In 2012, the International Transplant Centre in France(EBMT Paris Office) and the Hematology Department of the Saint-Antoine Hospital, with the help of EBMT, the Fondation de France and BOXIAO Foundation under the aegis of the Fondation de France decided to create an award entitled "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement/Young-Leader Award" in order to promote the innovations of Franco-Chinese cooperation in Hematology.

This award honors European / French or Chinese individuals or institutions for their contributions to the development of hematology particularly (but not exclusively) in the field of stem cell transplantation and cell therapy.

Call for applications for the "SAINT-ANTOINE-EBMT ACHIEVEMENT/ YOUNG-LEADER AWARD 2024" is posted on the website of SFGM-TC. SAINT-ANTOINE-EBMT ACHIEVEMENT AND YOUNG-LEADER AWARDS

Article 1

The International Transplant Centre in France (EBMT Paris Office) and the Hematology Department of the Saint-Antoine Hospital, with the help of the SFGMTC, the EBMT, and the financial support of the BOXIAO Foundation under the aegis of the Fondation de France decided to create two kinds of awards : one award entitled "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement Award" for senior confirmed team leaders and another one entitled "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Young Leader Award" in order to promote the innovations of Franco-Chinese cooperation in Hematology by senior as well as young leaders.

This award honors European / French or Chinese individuals or institutions for their contributions to the development of hematology particularly (but not exclusively) in the field of stem cell transplantation and cell therapy.

Article 2

The "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement / Young-Leader Award" is awarded annually to a maximum of two laureates by region, from China or Europe.

Article 3

Candidates must submit their CV with a list of publications and a summary of work they wish to do or descriptions of the work they have undertaken for the scientific cooperation described in Article 1. The document submitted (exclude the CV) will not exceed four A4 pages (single-spaced, 12 font).

Article 4

The jury is composed of scientists from the EBMT, from the Hematology Department of the Saint-Antoine Hospital and of representatives from the financial supporters. As required during the review of documents, the jury may seek external experts, especially Chinese experts for their opinions.

Article 5

The application for the "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement / Young-Leader Award" is open after January 1st each year.

Article 6

The laureates of the award are announced every year after the annual meeting of the SFGM-TC and the EBMT and/or if applicable during the "Franco-Chinese Summit in hematology" which may follow EBMT during the same year.

Article 7

The "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement / Young-Leader Award" is presented annually at the "Franco(European)-Chinese Summit in hematology" organized by the International Transplant Centre in France (EBMT Paris Office), the Saint-Antoine Hospital and the Chinese Medical Doctor Association. This scientific event takes place in France or in China.

Article 8

The "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement / Young-Leader Award" includes a certificate, a medal, an amount of 10,000 euros for "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Achievement Award" or an amount of 5,000 euros for "Saint-Antoine-EBMT Young-Leader Award". The certificate is signed by the president of the evaluation committee and the representative of the Saint-Antoine Hospital. The medal is engraved with the logo of the EBMT and the logo of the Saint-Antoine Hospital.

The presentation of the award will be in the presence of representatives from the laureates' country, the president of the Boxiao foundation and the president of the jury as well as attending jury members.

The Fondation de France will transfer the prize to the laureates who will also receive a congratulatory letter from the president of the Fondation de France.
